## Research Residency in Paris

### at the University of Chicago Center in Paris

University of Chicago faculty, graduate students, and alumni interested in conducting research in Paris are invited to apply for research residency at the University of Chicago Center in Paris.

#### **Terms and Conditions of Residency:**

Research Residents do not receive monetary stipends, but they do have access to resources provided by the Center (i.e. office space with plug-in and wireless internet access, access to an IT lab, laser printers, a photocopier, video-conferencing hardware and software). Research residents become part of a research community that benefits from formal and informal opportunities to share their work. During the academic year, Research Residents are expected to participate in the bi-weekly Center in Paris Interdisciplinary Workshop. (<http://pariscenter.uchicago.edu/grad/workshops.shtml>)

Residency is normally one quarter in duration, although applicants may request up to three consecutive quarters of residency with this application. Offices will be assigned according to need and availability. Some residents may share office space.

#### **Application Submission Guidelines:**

Applicants should complete the attached application form and submit it along with a CV and a one-page summary of the research they would conduct during residency. Applications from graduate students should also include a letter of recommendation from a faculty member. Applications from faculty members should include signatures from their respective Department Chair(s), Divisional Master(s), and Dean(s) if fellowship tenure is during a quarter that they are normally expected to be in residence in Chicago.

#### **Application Deadline:**

Applications may be submitted at any time, but first consideration will be given to applications and supporting materials received by February 15 for residency the following autumn and/or winter quarters, and by October 15 for the following spring and/or summer quarters.

#### **Notification:**

Applications will be evaluated by the Center in Paris Executive Committee. Applicants will be notified by email as to the committee's decision. Applications that are approved will be forwarded to the Administrative Director of the Center in Paris, who is in charge of assigning office space to research residents.
